

Hygiene and health controls



DESCRIPTION

Use of public pools involves a risk to public health in so far as the adequate health-sanitary conditions are not met or the treatment of the water is insufficient. As such, it is necessary to establish a protocol that ensures proper control of these municipal facilities.



OBJECTIVES

- Evaluation of the sanitary conditions of the municipally-managed municipal swimming pools.
- Identification of risk factors in swimming pools.
- Assessment of swimming pool basins and equipment.
- Communicate the deficiencies with higher associated risk.



Target

Public administrations, public companies and municipalities with competencies over the service.



ACTIONS

- Detailed inventory of all facilities.
- Analysis of water in swimming pools.
- Analysis of water used for filling the basin (required for individual tanks).
- Microbiological control of surfaces (showers, changing rooms, etc.).
- Physico-chemical and microbiological analyses and determination of Legionella spp and pneumophila.

- Water safety guarantee.
- Knowledge of possible sources of contamination
- Compliance with RD 742/2013.
